#### Japan

WHAT TO DO	In Tokyo, stroll under blooming canopies at Shinjuku Gyoen and along the Meguro River. Enjoy hanami picnics in Yoyogi Park or visit Meiji Shrine for a peaceful retreat. Sample street food near Ueno Park and savor sakura-themed treats at local cafés. In Kyoto, walk the Philosopher's Path lined with cherry trees and tea houses. Have hanami picnics in Maruyama Park or wander through Gion for blossoms against historic teahouses. Visit Arashiyama for blooms amid bamboo groves and scenic river views.


WHERE TO STAY Riggs Washington D.C., The Dupont Circle,
